



Europe's new hazard map








Europe's new hazard map

Multi-hazard exposure: Hazard types include floods, landslides, wildfires, coastal inundation, earthquakes, and subsidence

21.4% of European Local Administrative Units are exposed to multiple natural hazards, affecting approximately **87 million people (18.8% of the European population)**.










CYPRUS – Management of Wildfire / Earthquake Risks
