Addressing climate change: EU policy context

- European Green Deal (2019)

 EU climate neutral and resilient by 2050
- **EU Climate Law** (2021) → set into law climate objectives of Green Deal article 5 on adaptation
- **EU Adaptation Strategy** (2021) \Longrightarrow EU adapted to unavoidable climate impacts Strategy's central dimensions:
 - Smarter adaptation
 - More systemic adaptation
 - Faster adaptation

- Announced as 'European Climate Adaptation Plan' in the Political **Guidelines 2024-2029**



On this page, you will find information on funding sources from EU institutions, agencies and Member States governments to finance climate adaptation initiatives. This database is primarily aimed for use by EU regional and local authorities. However, it may also be relevant for businesses, organisations or research institutions.

Please note that this is not a database of open calls. It provides information about available funding sources at EU and national level that cover climate adaptation, and about entities that issue calls (it may include links to information on closed calls for future reference). For stakeholders who are new to funding opportunities and seeking guidance on adaptation project proposals, the Funding and Financing Guide is an essential resource to help navigate these

Users can filter database information by adaptation sectors, steps of the adaptation planning cycle (according to the RAST adaptation planning framework), country, and entities eligible to receive the funding.

This database covers funding for adaptation as a main focus but also includes funding sources for other related areas such as climate change mitigation, infrastructure, transport, and digital innovation. These funding sources can be relevant for adaptation-related actions, depending on the nature of the project and its alignment with broader climate objectives. It is important for stakeholders to review each funding option carefully, considering how their projects fit into the broader landscape of (climate) action, as certain funding sources may be flexible enough to support cross-cutting initiatives that address multiple climate goals simultaneously. It is recommended that you get in contact with the issuing funding entity before you submit an offer.

For more information on each EU funding option and eligibility, we encourage users to clarify any questions with the National Contact Points (NCPs), with a link to their contact details provided in the fund objective section. For more information on national funding options and eligibility, we encourage users to clarify any questions with the respective authorities.

Regional funding options are not covered by this database, but we encourage you to contact your regional authority to discuss funding options.


